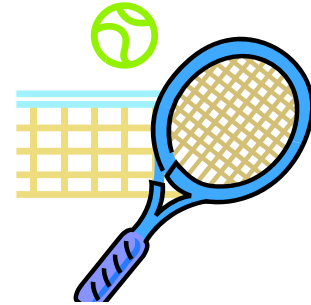

After requests from members of the tennis club to have access to the foam roller that helps dry out the courts after rain, the Committee has decided to make available to members a key to the caretaker's room where the roller is kept.

Because of valuable equipment kept in the room and it must be kept locked, for security reasons keys will **NOT** be kept at the clubhouse or with the Court Captain's keys. If members wish to dry the courts, they will have to go and get the key from one of three Committee members homes - Di Coghlan, Tony Kent or Graeme Gordon. **The person who takes the key will be held responsible for the security of the caretakers room, making sure that it is locked after the roller is returned after use, and for the return of the key to the Committee member.** The Court Captain(s) on duty at the time will still decide if the roller should be used.

Club members are advised that an **weekend emergency** phone number to reach the Council after hours has been fixed to the Tennis Club's wall in the store room.
